Robert Eberl and the Pasadena Central Library will be presenting the premiere of “Walk of Life – The Healing Experience of Music,” a unique musical event that debuts the Viennese self-care and performance strategist, speaker and author, on Saturday, June 18, 10:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., at the Donald R. Eberl will confer and perform a major and profound musical performance and speech about self-healing and how music can be used as a therapy to reduce stress and heal oneself.
